And the angle I took with congress was that we need to do all we can to prevent default and rehabilitate loans in tough economic times to prevent the current harm done to students by student loan default, and if rehabilitated, that should benefit the school's rates as well. We need incentives, not disincentives, to help students recover from the consequences of default. Also informed them that GAs recover 80-90% of defaults, and most of what remains after that is recovered through gov't collection tools. There is a real misconception that when someone defaults on 20k in federal student loans, that it costs taxpayers money, but the reality is it costs a fraction of that, and most likely is covered by the 1% G-fee. Defaults have a miniscule cost compared to Billions a minor increase in Pell costs.
